

**Ordinance 2009-5  
Town of Lynne  
Tripoli, WI 54564**

An Ordinance Related to  
**ENGINE BRAKING**

The Town of Lynne Board of Supervisors in the Town of Lynne, Oneida County Wisconsin, establishes this ordinance in accordance with Wisconsin State Statutes 60.22(1)

**Section 1: Purpose and Authority**

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish the prohibition of the use of engine brakes, also known as ‘Jake brakes’ on motor vehicles in order to prevent unnecessary noise.

**Section 2: Prohibited Activity**

No person shall use motor vehicle brakes on Willow Road from the town line with the Town of Minocqua south to Thunder Creek Road, and on Willow Road from Indian Village Road south to Highway 8, that are in any way activated or operated by the use of engine compression of any such motor vehicle or any such unit or part thereof, except in cases of emergency or necessary for the protection of persons or property. Emergency situations are defined as circumstances that could not reasonably be foreseen by an alert motor vehicle operator.

**Section 3: Enforcement & Penalty**

The provisions of this ordinance can be enforced by the proper law enforcement authorities having jurisdiction in the Town of Lynne including but not limited to the Oneida County Sheriff’s Department and the Wisconsin State Patrol. The penalty fine is **\$250** plus court costs and fees where applicable.
